Who's your team member and what score counts???

This is a FUN tournament. A 3-person team event that is a post-able round, but players will be "in the dark" about how many scores count until they get to the green of each hole. Players register as teams if they meet the high, med & low handicap requirements. Singles may also register and they will be formed into teams by the Tournament Coordinator. Guests are welcome, but if they are not NCGA members, they must provide an accurate estimate of their handicap. So, make a "blind date" to compete for fun

Tournament Format & Guidelines

Play will proceed according to net best ball rules with all golfers playing their own ball from tee to holeout. Teams are composed of low, medium and high handicappers selected by the Tournament Coordinator. 100% of course handicaps will be used.

The following will determine how scores are recorded on each team's card:

- Teams shall record the gross score of each individual player on the card; however, a prior blind draw will determine whether 1, 2 or 3 scores shall be counted for the final team score.
- A tag that will disclose the number of scores to be counted will be placed on every flag, Teams will not have that information until they reach each green. Overall, there will be six 1-score holes, six 2-score holes and six 3-score holes distributed randomly over the golf course.
- The final score for each hole shall be the best net score or combination of scores as indicated by the flag tag. Tournament officials will compute the deduction of handicap strokes from the gross recorded scores. Illegible scorecards will be subject to interpretation by scorers their decision is final
- **Do not post scores.** Scores will be posted by the Club Handicap Chairman.
- **Pace of play suggestions:** To speed up play, individual players shall pick up after their strokes for a hole reach a net double bogey. NCGA rules are in effect. Play the ball down. If your ball finds a divot in the fairway ONLY, you may drop within 12" of the original lie. Teams who finish more than 30 minutes behind the group directly in front of them maybe be assessed a two-stroke. penalty. **Keep up with the group in front of you. PLAY READY GOLF!!!!!!**
