The King of the Mountain Cup (KOM) is a season-long competition designed to identify the best stroke play golfer at Apple Mountain. The KOM cup is comprised of 5 preliminary events, with points awarded for each event, plus a final round double point event.

The Stroke Play Series is just individual stroke play tournaments played in conjunction with the KOM tournaments to allow players who don't want to compete in the KOM series to play in the individual tournaments. Each event is a combined tournament and offers payouts as with any other tournament.

Tournament Information

- KOM has a one-time registration Fee of \$20. These monies will go to the end of year payouts. You must pay the one-time registration fee before you play your first tournament.
- In the Stroke play Series, there is no one time registration fee just your tournament fee for the day to play in any of the individual tournaments. There is also no end of year payout as there are no points awarded for the Stroke play series.
- Each of the 6 KOM Events are stand-alone tournaments and have a separate entry fee of \$25 (plus your regular green fee.) \$5 from KOM player entry fees goes to the end-of-the-year prize fund. If you're just playing in the Individual Stroke play portion, and not registered for KOM, all your entry fee will go to that day's prize fund.
- Flights and tee boxes will be determined by the number of participants in each event. There could be 1-4 flights, depending on the number of entries.
- Each Flight for KOM will be awarded points for 1st -4th place as well as participation points.
- The Final event will be open to all, and **Points will be doubled**.
- End of season prizes: 1st place – **Gold Membership**; 2nd place – **half a Gold Membership** There could also be cash prize payouts at the end of season depending on participation throughout the season.

5. KOM #5 – Tuesday July 16
6. KOM Final – Tuesday Aug 13

KOM Scoring and Point Awards System

The King of the Mountain Cup is a cumulative points competition. Points are awarded according to order of finish in each regular season KOM event within the flights. The chart displays the number of points awarded to each place. Players whose scores are tied at the end of a round will use the standard USGA tie breaker. There will always be a clear winner of each flight. In the event of a tie for KOM there will be a playoff to determine the KOM season winner.

Registration

Players are entered into the King of the Mountain Cup competition by signing up and paying your 20.00 registration fee. All KOM competitions are open to all golfers but to accumulate points you must register and pay your onetime 20.00 registration fee. Players increase their chances of reaching the KOM finals by competing in the all the KOM events. The more events a player competes in, the more Points you accumulate. A portion of the prize fees in each of the KOM events will be used for the Finals prize fund.

Prizes

The winner, at the end of the King of the Mountain Final will be awarded a gold membership. The 2nd place finisher will be awarded a ½ gold membership. The rest of the season payouts will depend on the prize fund and number of entries.
