

Player of the Year

Objective –

Get as many Apple Mountain Golf Club members as possible to participate in all golf tournaments, whether they are more interested in fun or serious tournaments and gross or net scoring. This is accomplished by giving the most number of participants a chance to win something based on their gross or net score.

Procedures (see attached worksheet) –

1. Player of the Year (POY) points will be awarded starting from January 1. The top 25 players in the POY standings and all flight winners during the year prior to the President's Invitational Tournament will be invited to play in the Tournament. Board membership and POY standings will be used to determine the players invited to play in the Cyder Cup.
2. The number of POY points awarded will be based on the nature of the tournament, not the amount of prize money collected from participants. The Winter League, Spring Fourth, Senior Club Championship, Club Championship and Match Play Championship will award double POY points. Other tournaments that are conducted over two or more days will also award double POY points. Participation points will be awarded for each day of the Member-Guest Tournament (including Skins competition), but no other points will be awarded.
3. NCGA Club qualifying tournaments that do not also include a non-NCGA qualifying tournament will not be eligible for POY points.
4. Each tournament will have a number of flights based on how many players or teams have entered the tournament, with the objective of giving the most number of players a chance to win POY points. An attempt will be made to have an equal number of players or teams in each flight. The actual number will be based on a natural break of GHIN and handicaps, which could result in an unequal number of players or teams in each flight.
5. POY points will be based on the number of players or teams in each flight, with a higher number of points being awarded when the flight size is larger. A minimum number of points will be awarded for flights of five or less players or teams. In a team event, the individual players will receive points based on how many players are on each team. For example, if a 3-man team earns 60 points, each player will earn 20 points.
6. The tees played from will be determined after a review of the number of flights and the number of players in each flight. The low handicap flight may play from the Blue tees or Combo tees, depending on the nature of the tournament. The other flights may play from the White tees, White/Gold Combo tees and/or Gold tees (men) or Red tees (women). Men over 70 years of age or with a GHIN Index of 20 or higher, will be encouraged, but not required, to play from the White/Gold or Gold tees.
7. POY points will be awarded to approximately 35-40 percent of the players in each flight. Two participation points will be awarded to each player for each day of a tournament. Winter League, Spring Fourth, Senior Club Championship, Club Championship and Match

Play Championship participants will be awarded a total of four participation points. Member-Guest Tournament participants will be awarded two points for each day played (including Skins competition).

8. For those tournaments that award gross and net score awards, any player that wins a gross award cannot also win a net award. If the gross award winner would have also won a net award, the net award is given to next highest net placement. For example, if the gross winner also placed second net in a flight that awarded three net prizes, the person who placed third net would receive the award for second place net and the person who placed fourth net would receive the award for third place net.
9. The Tournament Handicap Policy will be in effect for all tournaments. Other handicap adjustments will be based on the tournament format as recommended by the USGA.
10. Deadlines for entering tournaments will be Tuesday (for Saturday tournaments) or Wednesday (for Sunday tournaments). All fees related to the tournament must be paid before tournament play begins.
11. The POY standings will be posted on the Club website. An abbreviated version will be printed in each newsletter.
12. At the end of the year, dollar prizes will be awarded to the top five places in the POY standings: 1st - \$60, 2nd - \$50, 3rd - \$40, 4th - \$30, 5th - \$20.
13. If the Tournament Committee determines that these Procedures have not resulted in a fair distribution of POY points, it reserves the right to change the Procedures at any time.

- 4 Participation and Placement Points will be doubled for all multi-day Tournaments (Winter League, Spring Fourth & Player Appreciation)
- 5 Ryder Cup Rumble - (Points earned/6) x 6. Match winners given 4 additional points, losers 2 additional points.
